

NATIVITY SCHOOL EXTENDED DAY CARE PROGRAM

Authorization for Medication of Child by Extended Day Care Personnel

A parent/guardian must bring this completed form and the medication **to the Extended Day Care site supervisor**. The medication must have the student's name on it and must be in the original prescription container. For the protection of all concerned, regulations forbid students from bringing medication, either prescription or non-prescription, onto the school campus. Under no circumstances will the Extended Day Care personnel administer medication removed from the pharmacy container.

Education Code 49423 and 49423.5: "Any pupil who is required to take, during the regular school day, medication prescribed for him/her by a physician, may be assisted by the school nurse or other designated school personnel if the school receives (1) a written statement from such physician detailing the method, amount, and the time schedules by which such medication is to be taken and (2) a written statement from the parent or guardian of the pupil indicating the desire that the school assist the pupil in the matters set forth in the physician's statement.
